I have a few uncles who have played this game for 22 years. They have won thousands of dollars. The lost money to but they won MORE than they lost.

I won too several times too but I wasn't the greatest player, I was just "good".

So I asked them "What's your secret?"... All my uncles laughed at first. I then told them I was serious.

So after writing down in a piece of paper everything they told they used. I gathered it here for the forum members.

Baccarat Tips

Myths - Looking for patterns: Looking for patterns in baccarat is as pointless as it is in roulette, they are both games of chance where the previous play never influences the next play. This is a simple trap that many novice gamblers all around the world fall into when playing any game of chance. If you were betting on the flip of a coin, and it landed heads up 9 times in a row many gamblers would say the chances of tails as a next land have increased, but of course they have not. The chances remain 50 -50 for the next toss.

Myths - Systems: Casino's give out cards where you can write down the games history, but this is really entertainment and won't increase the odds of success. Finally, never buy a system for money the sales copy may sound good but by the nature of the game they can never work.

Baccarat Strategy

Baccarat is a game of chance. There's no use in trying to count cards, because it will not help you in this game. Instead, use your time to focus on the game itself - not the cards.

Don't use baccarat systems. It is futile to base your gaming decisions on results of previous bets. Choose the game with as few decks as possible.

Look for the casino that charge a commission on banker bets lower than 5% if you can find one.- The casino bonuses found on the left menu are some nice casinos to look into.

Money management.

It's very important to understand the financial side of the game. Divide up your money and control how much you bet at each round. One of the best ways to manage your money during the play is to pocket a certain percentage of your winnings each time you win or to pocket it all. A smart player ALWAYS Bets on the banker. This bet has the lowest house edge and is the one to go for. Know when to call it a night. Try to pace yourself and always avoid losing it all early in the game. Never bet more money than you can afford. This behavior goes against the money management theory and will cost you in the end.

As you can see there baccarat is a game of chance and my (uncles) baccarat strategy is very simple but it will maximize your odds.

There is only ONE good bet for winning at Baccarat and you must use it frequently.

Use the banker bet the most, for variety you may want to bet on the player occasionally and never bet on the tie. If you

want to use a system to make the game more enjoyable I suggest the 1-3-2-6 system I explained for roulette. It can be used for baccarat also when betting on the banker; however it cannot beat the house edge so leave the table when you're winning.

I hope this helped out for you members.
