So how do you research a casino?

GOOGLE it. It's take a very small amount of time to google. For example if the casino is called "Vegas Poker"

Search this "Vegas Poker forums" "Vegas Poker complaints" "Vegas Poker scam"

Cash bonuses are perfect for noobs. And actually, the answer to your question is Yes. Cash bonuses can help you.

But be careful, casinos generally use this to entice you and then make you addicted. Then you spend your own money and they pray you will lose.

When starting out, do this for FUN.

Gambling is about winning. But it shouldn't be considered your income source. That would be really pathetic and you'll be broke.

Start out with what you can afford.

\$20 daily? \$100 weekly? Don't go crazy.

The truth is in the long run you will MAKE MORE MONEY by following this advice.

Why? It is simple common sense and a matter of mathematical calculations.

Think about if you have \$1000 bucks or pounds. If you were cash in chips for poker.

here's scenario A - You put \$500 bucks on the line at one single day. You will most likely lose. Why? Your risk is getter, your money will be gone much quicker and your playing less. Which basically means, your given less chances to win.

here's scenario A- You put \$75 bucks on the line in one day. You may lose for today but the next day you may win, may lose. If you lose, no problem. You still have money so you can play the next day. you play the next day. BINGO. You won lets say \$125 bucks.

It may sound corny but EVERY successful gambler says "Play with your HEAD not with your heart"

Think logically not emotionally.

Most people want to get up making thousands in a single night. Problem is they risk money they can't afford to lose.

Once you start winning. Save that up and play with part of the money you won and then slowly build up on a budget you can afford to LOSE.

That's how all Pros play.

The next thing.

What game to choose? And do you know how to play?

First, know the rules and know how to play. Many casinos actually are fair enough to let you play for free and risk fake money.

If you don't have discipline know. Practice on fake play money. It will help you. DO IT!

Also it will teach you the game and build up your skills.

The other factor is whether you are skillful. Gambling is gambling but part of it is also with some skills too. If you don't know how to play, your playing with fire. So make sure you know the rules and you have had some practice time.

Once you feel comfortable, then begin playing with real money.
